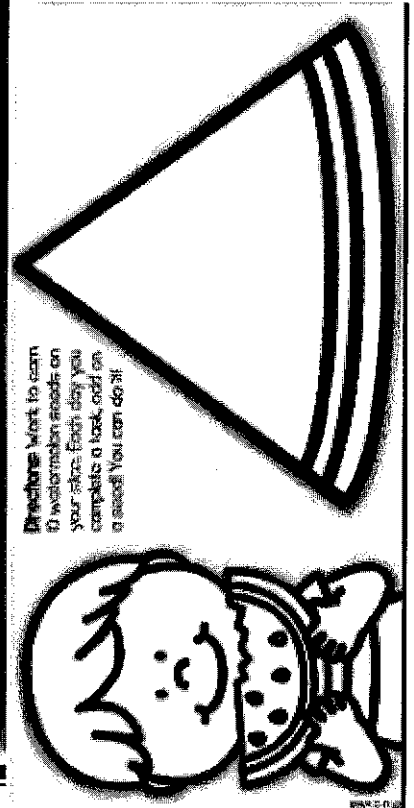


Learning Mat: Week 1

Ex: 5 and 5	Today you will work to solve a word problem. My mom made cookies. 10 were chocolate chip and 5 were sugar cookies. How many cookies all together?	Today you will work fast and fluently. Listen as your parent reads these facts. You will call out the answer as quickly as possible. 10+2, 10+5, 10+8, 10+6, 10+9, 10+1, 10+3, 10+7.

On each line, write a word in the -et family.	Write a sentence using 2 of your popcorn words from our lists. Don't forget to use a capital and a period.	Today you will work fast and fluently to state sounds of the alphabet. Say a random letter A-Z and your child will respond with that letter's sound. Example, if you say, B, they will call back, /b/.

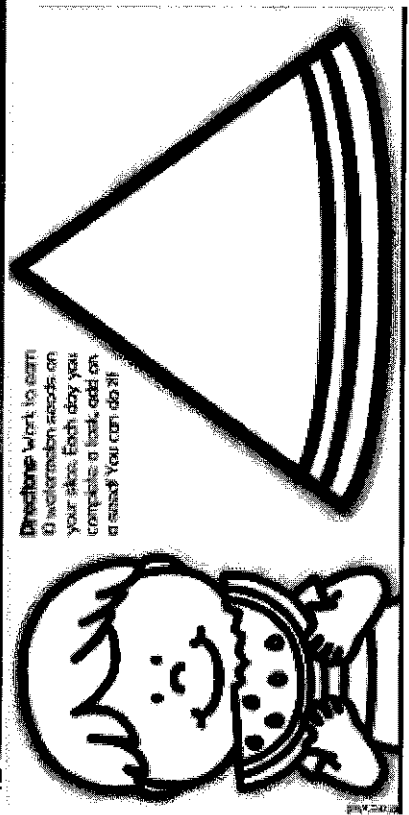
